Subject: Important Update: New Personal Device Policy for 2025 School Year

Oki Siksika Board of Education Parents, Guardians, and Community Members,

We want to inform you about an important change coming to our school that will help create a more focused learning environment for our students.

Starting January 6, 2025, we're implementing new guidelines for personal electronic devices in alignment with Alberta's province-wide initiative to enhance student learning and well-being.

What This Means for Your Child:

During class time, all personal electronic devices must be:

- Turned off completely
- Stored out of sight (in lockers, backpacks, or designated areas)

This policy applies to:

- Cell phones and smartphones
- Smart watches
- Headphones
- Other personal electronic devices

Understanding the Exemptions:

We recognize that some students require access to their devices for essential purposes. Approved exemptions include:

- 1. Medical and Health Needs:
 - Monitoring medical conditions (such as diabetes with blood sugar tracking)

- Managing health-related apps or devices
- o Emergency medical alerts
- 2. Special Learning Needs:
 - Assistive technology for learning disabilities
 - Digital learning aids for coded students as prescribed in Individual Program Plans (IPPs)
 - Specialized learning accommodations
- 3. Teacher-Directed Learning (with prior principal approval):
 - Specific educational activities requiring device use
 - Research projects
 - Interactive learning programs
 - Digital presentations
- 4. Case-by-Case Situations (with prior principal approval):
 - Special circumstances approved by the principal non
 - Temporary accommodations for specific needs
 - Emergency family situations

To Request an Exemption:

- Submit a written request to the school administration
- Provide supporting documentation (medical notes, learning assessments, etc.)
- Meet with appropriate staff to discuss accommodations
- Await formal written approval before device use

This new policy will help:


- Maximize learning time in the classroom
