Certified Teachers are responsible for delivering Alberta curriculum in a safe, inclusive, and culturally responsive learning environment. Teachers are expected to demonstrate competencies aligned with Alberta’s Teaching Quality Standard (TQS) and contribute to the academic, social, and emotional development of students. This includes integrating Siksika language, culture, and Ways of Knowing into classroom practice where appropriate.

What You’ll Do:

- Deliver instruction based on Alberta Education’s program of studies
- Develop and implement lesson plans that reflect diverse learning needs
- Assess and evaluate student progress using a variety of tools and strategies
- Foster student engagement, inquiry, and perseverance in learning
- Apply trauma-informed, strengths-based, and restorative practices
- Collaborate with Educational Assistants and support staff
- Support students with diverse learning and behavioral needs (e.g., ADHD, FASD, Autism)
- Use digital tools such as Google Workspace, PowerSchool, Smartboards, and Microsoft Office
- Integrate Siksika perspectives and land-based learning into instruction
- Participate in offsite activities such as field trips, powwows, and cultural events
- Maintain regular communication with families and participate in school-wide events
- Participate in supervision duties and contribute to a safe school environment
- Work alongside a multi-disciplinary team to meet the growth and development needs of students
- Engage in ongoing professional learning aligned with the TQS
