About the Role

The Transportation Supervisor is a key operational leader within the Siksika Board of Education (SBE). This position is responsible for ensuring safe, reliable, and efficient transportation of students within and beyond the Siksika Nation. The Supervisor provides leadership and oversight in operational planning, community engagement, and service delivery. With foundational systems and relationships already in place, this role welcomes a leader who can bring fresh perspective, strengthen existing practices, and guide the department into its next phase of growth.

What You'll Do

- Build on existing transportation policies and practices, identifying areas for refinement and innovation
- Serve as a visible and trusted leader within the Nation, fostering strong relationships with families, schools, and community partners
- · Provide oversight and guidance for daily transportation operations, with support from experienced staff
- Lead daily transportation operations, including early-morning dispatch, troubleshooting, and route adjustments
- Support coordination of School trip logistics and route adjustments, with a focus on efficiency and student safety
- Approve timesheets, verify invoices, and maintain accurate records of fleet and driver activity
- Partner with HR to improve onboarding, modified work, and incident response processes
- Work closely with the Transportation Assistant and Office Support staff to manage routing, field trips and contractor coordination
- Ensure timely communication and support for staffing managing AP's, fuel subsidies, and contractor paperwork
- Provide leadership and stability in high-pressure environments, especially during peak scheduling periods and school-wide events

- 3+ years of experience in transportation or fleet management
- Knowledge of Alberta Transportation Regulations and CVIP requirements
