August 29, 2025 – Regular Meeting of the SBE Board of Directors Summary

1. Motions:

- #2025.08.29.92 – MOVED to approve the purchase of four sensory nooks at the total cost of \$103,150.04 to support sensory-friendly environments for students. All in favour. MOTION CARRIED.
- #2025-08-29-93 – MOVED to approve the travel for the Superintendent or designated Siksika Board of Education representative and/or board member to meet with government regarding funding for the new middle school. All in favour. MOTION CARRIED.
- #2025.08.29.94 – MOVED to approve the purchase of five new bus units at a total cost of \$886,652 to support fleet needs. Surplus funds will be used to cover the costs for this expenditure and no programs will be impacted. All in favour. MOTION CARRIED.
- #2025.08.29.95 – MOVED to approve the allocation of \$104,000 from surplus funds for the replacement of window blinds at Siksika Nation High School. All in favour. MOTION CARRIED.
- #2025.08.29.96 – MOVED to approve the Request for Proposal (RFP) for the Architectural Services for the Preliminary Designs for the new middle school. All in favour. Carried.
- #2025.08.29.97 – MOVED to approve the allocation of \$500,000 from the remaining Chief Crowfoot School Capital funds to initiate the design phase for a new middle school, including the issuance of an RFP for architectural proposals, with the goal of being shovel ready for future development. All in favour. MOTION CARRIED.
- #2025.08.29.100 – MOVED to approve and adopt the updated Mission, Vision, and Values as presented on August 29, 2025. The presented statements will take effect immediately and guide all future planning and operations for the Siksika Board of Education. All in favour. MOTION CARRIED.
- #2025.08.29.101 – MOVED to accept and approve the listed, updated, and revised Administrative Regulation policies as presented on August 29, 2025:
 - Student Conduct
 - Welcoming, Caring, Respectful and Safe Learning Environment
 - Concerns and Complaints
 - Fleet Vehicles (Excluding School Buses)
